The **Albany Humane Society, Inc.** is a non-profit corporation formed to prevent cruelty to animals; provide services that assist other agencies in dealing with the legal/health consequences of animals who interface with human populations; relieve the suffering of animals; and extend humane education to people in the greater Dougherty County area of Southwest Georgia.

The **Georgia Department of Agriculture Equine Impound Program** is charged with the duty of ensuring that Georgia's equines receive humane care, including receiving adequate food and water. If owners do not comply with the state's laws concerning the health and welfare of their equine, the state has the authority and obligation to impound the animals in negligent owners' care. Since there are **no state appropriated funds** for the impound program, the department relies on the proceeds from the sale of the rehabilitated equines and donations from the public to continue caring for Georgia's abused and neglected horses, donkeys, mules, and ponies.

Traveling South on I-75

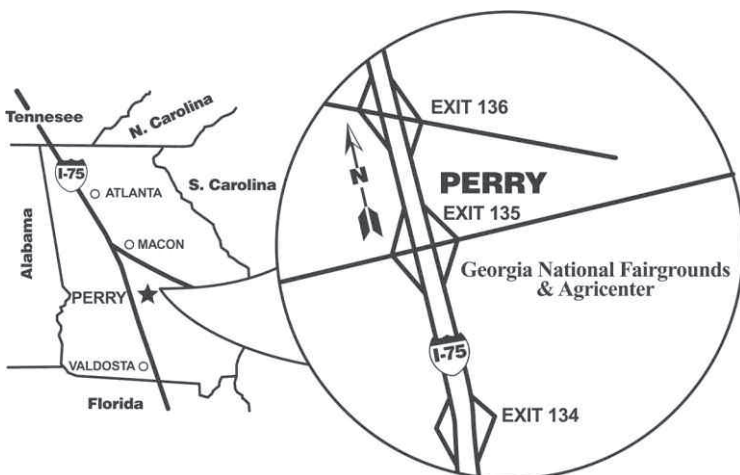
Exit 135

Exit 134

- To Enter South Gate: Turn left at end of the exit ramp
Cross over the interstate, take first left onto Fairgrounds

NOTE: North, South, and West Gates may be closed due to special requirements for certain events. East Gate is accessible 24 hours.



General Rules and Information

1. Any person entering the show grounds is responsible for knowing and agreeing to abide by the rules and regulations issued by the show committee as a condition of entry.
2. Show management reserves the right to combine, split or cancel any class.
3. All entries that pre-register will receive a \$2 discount per class. Pre-registration Available online through www.gaitkeeper.com or by mail. **In order to receive Discount by mail, entries (accompanied by check) must be postmarked no later than September 26, 2011. Early Bird Drawing for FREE Stall if paid by August 31, 2011.**
4. To enter a championship class, the exhibitor/horse combination must participate in a previous class of the same kind. (See Class Schedule for details).
5. To register for an additional class or make a change, exhibitors must register at least Three classes prior to the class they want to enter. Drop/Add should be done at Registration. Failure to do so, will result in forfeiture of fees.
6. The wearing of USEF approved hard hats by all junior exhibitors is required. Protective headgear and proper attire is mandatory in all classes unless it states Otherwise in the description of the class. Hard hats must be worn in schooling areas. **Back numbers must be visible at all times.**
7. Order of work will be determined by the paddock master. Notify the paddock master and/or show steward of any conflicts.
8. NO Schooling over fences. Warm up classes will be provided for a \$5 fee.
9. Horses may not enter more than 2 consecutive height division and no more than seven fence classes per show day.
10. Classes will be called promptly. The USEF Two minute gate rule will be enforced. Tack holds will be granted for horses or exhibitors in back to back classes only. All requests for tack holds should be made at registration.
11. All children s and junior s horses must be handled by the junior exhibitor in all phases Of a class.
12. In the event that due to illness or failure of a show official to attend this show or perform their duties, the show committee reserves the right to substitute another show official.
13. Any Act of discourtesy to a judge or show official on the part of any trainer, owner, exhibitor or groom will immediately disqualify any horse with which they are associated and entry fees will be forfeited.
14. Management reserves the right to decline an exhibitor s entry or any horse before the show and reserves the right to order from the premises during the show any person without being liable for compensation.
15. Stalls are reserved on a first pay basis and will not be confirmed until payment is received. Horses not stalled will be charged a **\$25 grounds fee.**
16. No refunds will be made after the show begins except for lameness or illness of horse with vet certificate or illness with doctor s excuse.
17. A **current negative Coggins test** is required for all horses entering the show grounds.
18. Dogs must be leashed at all times. Dogs are not allowed in Arenas or show areas.
19. Only licensed drivers 18 years of age or older are permitted to drive or operate golf carts.

All payback class winners will receive vouchers with their placings. Voucher must

be redeemed by the end of the show, otherwise they will be void. Vouchers will be

redeemed at the registration office located in the Coral.

In order to receive payout, class must have at least 3 entries. **

Open Hunter Division Any horse/pony who has not jumped over 2 6

Pony Hunter Division Any pony who has not jumped over 2 6

(Pony distances will be measured based on a 12 foot stride)

Hopeful Hunter 2'-2'3" Open to all horses & ponies which have not jumped over 2 6

Low Hunter 2'6" Open to all horses and ponies which have not jumped over 2 9

****A.C. \$300 Hunter Derby Round 1:** To be shown over natural hunter course of 8 jumps at 2 6, with 2 optional fences at 2 9. An in & out, a bending line, and minimum of 1 unrelated distance included.

Round 2: Hunter course 2 6, with 2 optional fences at 2 9. Will include minimum of 2 of the following: Trot jump, lead over jump, tight turn option, optional approaches; halt and/or back, walk a jump. **All entries from Round 1 will be eligible to participate in Round 2.** Ribbons awarded in both rounds.

Prize money & awards for top combined scores. 1st - \$200, 2nd - \$100.

Awards or ribbons to 6th place. Less than 5 entries will run as a 50/50.

Pre-Beginner: Open to riders in their first year of showing over fences.

Coaches/handlers are permitted in ring to preserve safety of exhibitors.

Beginner Rider: Open to riders in their first 2 years of showing O/F. No penalty for trotting course.

Beginner Horse: Open to horses and ponies in their first 2 years of showing O/F. No penalty for trotting.

Cross Rails 12": Riders cannot show in any O/F classes over 12

Cross Rails 18 : Riders in first 2yrs of showing 18 cross rails may cross enter to 2 cross rails.

Novice Jumper Horses or ponies which have not jumped over 2 3.

Pony Jumper Ponies which have not jumped over 2 3.

Beginner Jumper Horses or ponies which have not jumped over 2 6.

Open Jumper Progressive Open to all horse or ponies.

Clear rounds will progress to the next round with selected fences being raised 3 inches per round until there is one winning entry. Time faults will apply after 2 minutes.* Awards 50% payback to the winner.

****A.C. \$250 Jumper Challenge** Open to all riders; Awards: 1st - \$175.00
2nd - \$75.00; 3rd - \$50.00. Less than 5 entries will run as a 50/50.

****A.C. \$1,000 Mini Grand Prix** Open to all riders. Awards: 1st - \$500;
2nd - \$300; 3rd - \$125; 4th - \$75. Minimum 8 entries required to pay \$1,000.
Less than 8 entries will run as a 50/50. *Must enter at least 1 other jumper class.
